1. Have you heard about Russia's newly proposed Part Four of the Civil Code? Base: 81

2. What is your attitude toward the proposed Part Four of the Civil Code? Base: 76

Very positive	8%

3. In your opinion, if the proposed Part Four of the Civil Code is adopted, what will happen?
 Base: 76
